Grown-ups:

Make a picture book!

Make a book about what your child likes. What do you like? Let's draw a picture! Let's take a photograph!

Could you make time to make a picture book with your child? You can use the mini book and help your child draw or make a picture of what they like. Talk to your child about what they like and tell them what you like. It can be as easy as talking about their favourite colour and using coloured pens, pencils or paint to make marks in the book. You could even take a picture of the things your child likes and stick it in the book!

Learning to communicate with others about themselves is an important process for children. It helps them develop language and vocabulary. Early mark making will encourage children's later writing skills.
