Grown-ups:

Look for shapes and colours!

When you are at home, or out and about, help your child name the shapes and colours that they see.

Could you make time to name colours and shapes with your child?

Looking at different shapes and naming them will help your child understand that everyday objects have particular shapes. For example, look at the front door and name the shape of it with your child.

Enjoy naming lots of colours with your child and see how many things they can see that are the same colour! Learning to differentiate, sort and categorise things and objects is an important process for children. It helps them develop their logical thinking and problem solving skills.
