

How Many?

This activity will help you learn more about counting objects and what the numbers say. You can even try and write the numbers! All of the objects that are in the pictures I found at home. Once you have finished the counting activity, you could see what collections of objects you can find in your home to count!

Look at the pictures and count how many objects are in each picture.

Use your finger to touch each object as you count and as you touch it say the first number, then the next number in order. "one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten."
