
Summer Time at Nursery

We can pretend there is a bubble round us. By staying in our bubble we are keeping safe.




This means at Nursery we cannot hold our friends hands, hug them or sit next to them.

We can play outside but not on the climbing frame or the trim trail.














We can paint, draw and play with some toys.
