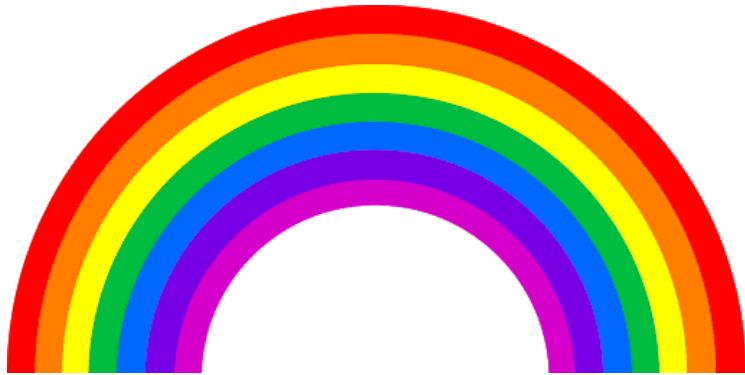
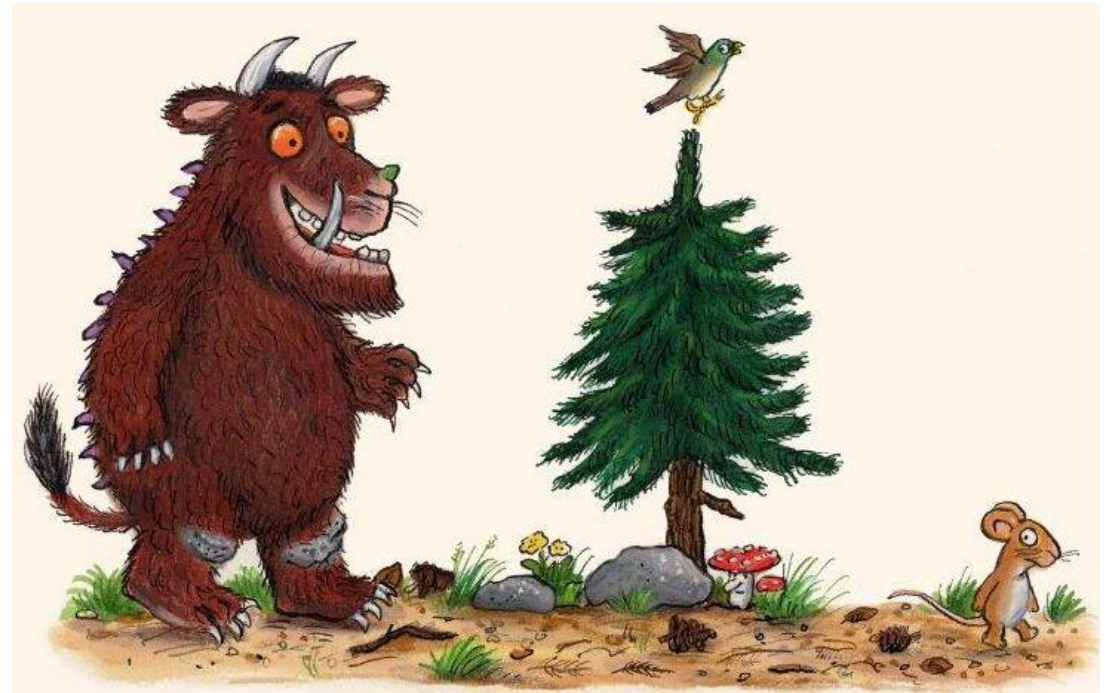


# Summer Time at Nursery



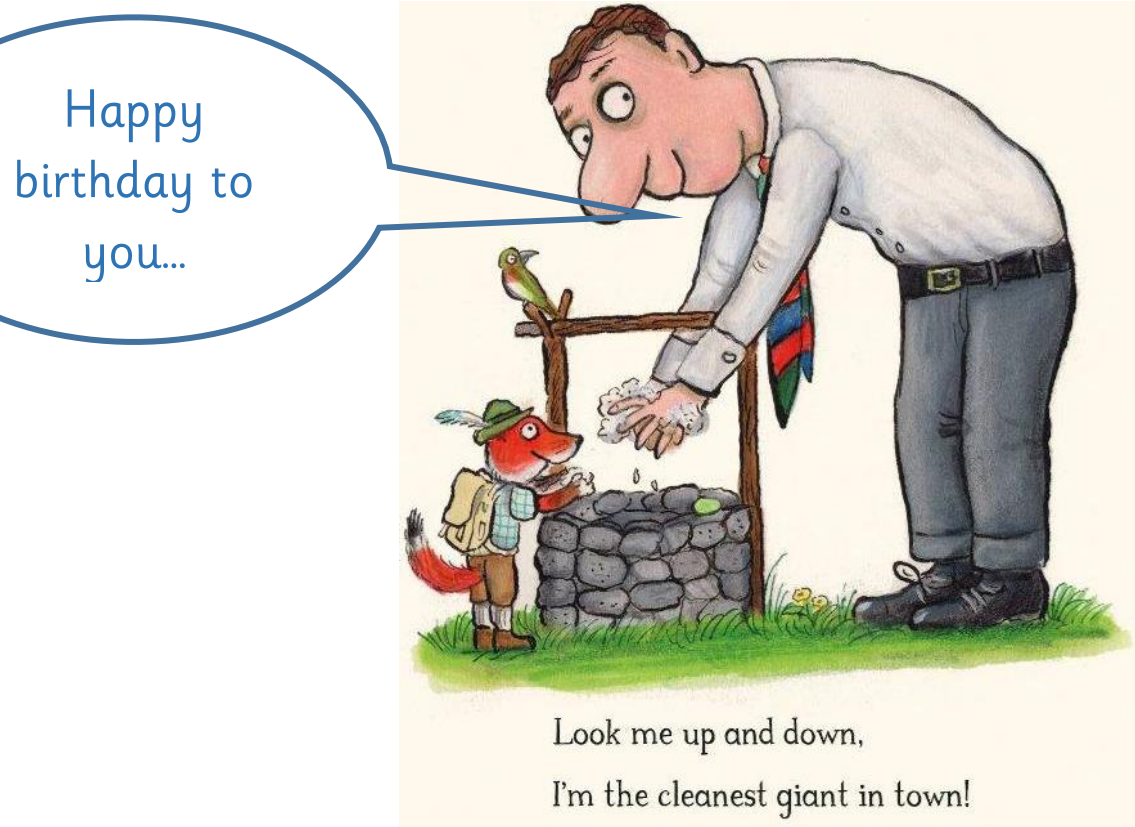
Things will be a little bit different at Nursery now but we can still have lots of fun.

We can play outside but not on the climbing frame or the trim trail.

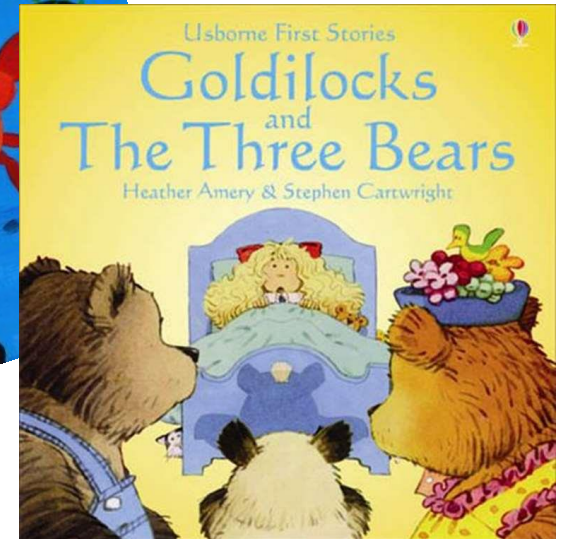




We can paint, draw and play with some toys.
