As scientists we will learn about: Amazing Bodies		You will remember:
	The total amount and range of foods eaten is called a person's diet. A balanced diet includes carbohydrates, proteins, fats, water, fibre, vitamins and minerals.	In Year 2, you learnt that all living things need food, water, and air to survive.
	Carbohydrates provide you with energy to move and keep you warm. e.g. pasta, potatoes, bread	In Year 2, you learnt that potatoes are grown in our local area.
	Protein is needed for growth and to make you strong. e.g. eggs, meat, fish, nuts	In Year 2, you learnt that food comes from either plants or animals.
	The 3 main functions of a skeleton are: - Protection - Movement - Support	In Year 1, you learnt that a mammal is a vertebrate that has its skeleton on the inside.



Art and Design Key knowledge to be transferred to long term memory

	When completing a chest pass the ball should be held in front of the chest with the elbows tucked in. Step in the direction of the pass. Push the ball from the chest with both arms.	In Year 2, you learnt that dribbling is being able to move a ball while staying in control of it.
