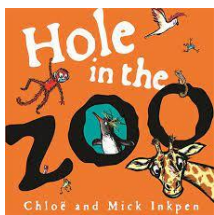

Welcome back to Term 6. We hope you have had an enjoyable break.

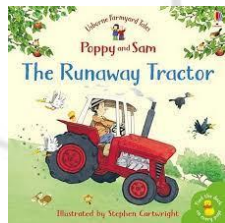
Our Theme



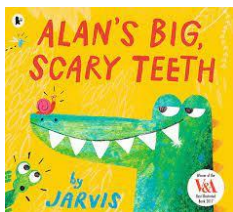
Our theme this term is 'Farms and Zoos'. We will be exploring different farm and zoo animals, the importance of weather, animal habitats, farm vehicles,

We will share our own experiences and explore the food that we get from the farm as well as harvest



some of the vegetables we have been growing in our allotment.



We will also explore oral health with Alan the Crocodile and we will be helping Alan to look after his teeth.

In phonics, we will continue to explore the letters **s, a, t, p, i** and **n** as well as the letters in our names.

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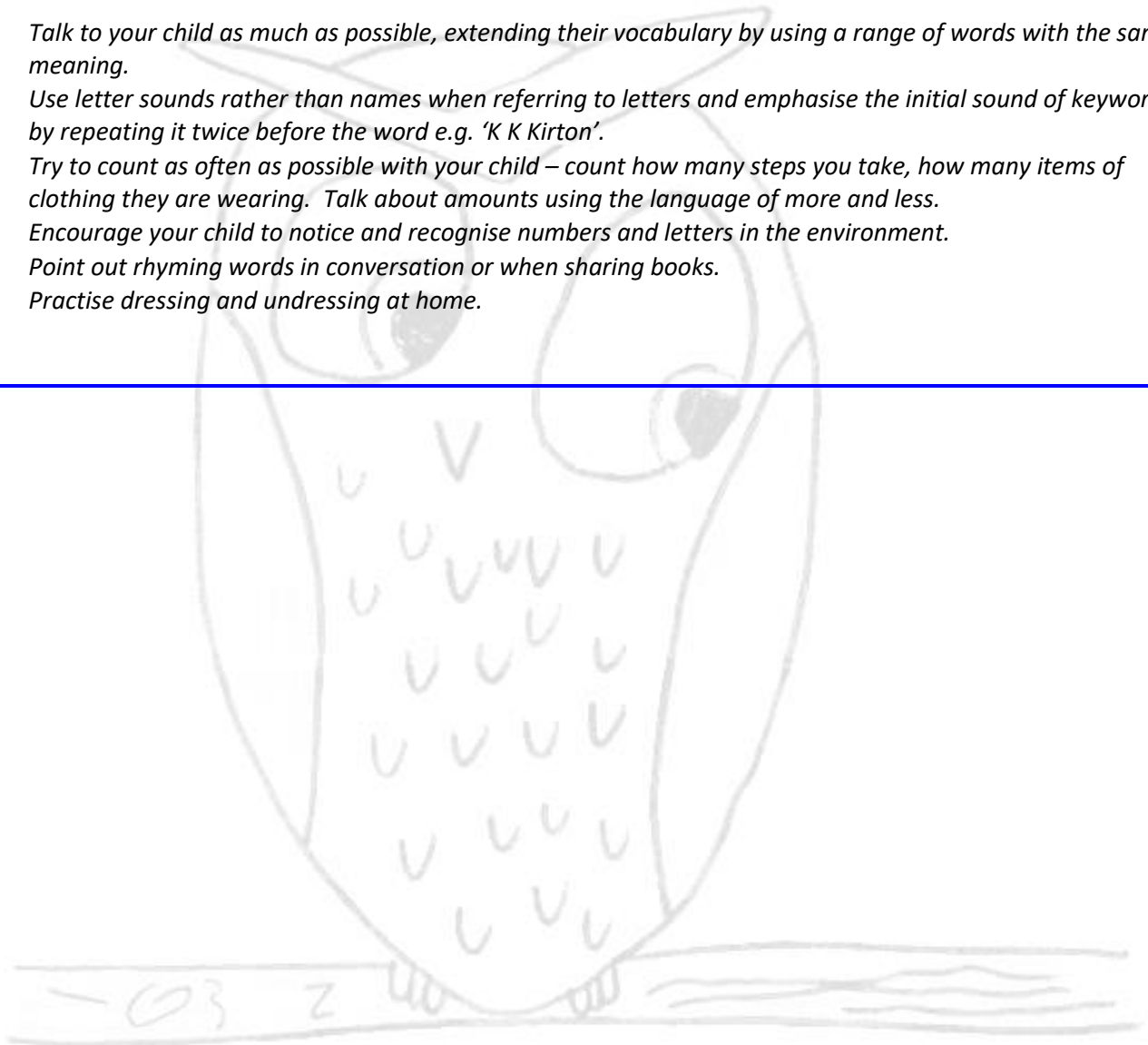


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HOW YOU CAN SUPPORT YOUR CHILD'S LEARNING THIS TERM:

Key things that parents can do to support their child this term related to things they will be learning about:

- *Talk to your child as much as possible, extending their vocabulary by using a range of words with the same meaning.*
- *Use letter sounds rather than names when referring to letters and emphasise the initial sound of keywords by repeating it twice before the word e.g. 'K K Kirton'.*
- *Try to count as often as possible with your child – count how many steps you take, how many items of clothing they are wearing. Talk about amounts using the language of more and less.*
- *Encourage your child to notice and recognise numbers and letters in the environment.*
- *Point out rhyming words in conversation or when sharing books.*
- *Practise dressing and undressing at home.*





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Farm Colour By Numbers


Match the colours to the numbers.

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Jungle Animal Home Learning Challenge




The little boy was listening carefully when he walked through the jungle. Go for a walk with a grown-up and then draw some of the things you could hear on your walk.

The animals all move in different ways. Move around like the different animals and see if the people at home can guess which animal you are pretending to be!



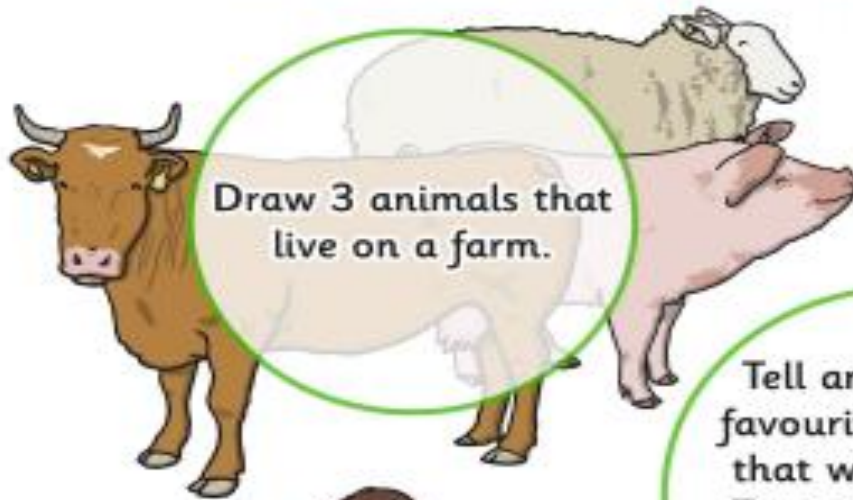
Imagine the little boy went for a walk somewhere else, maybe a farm or the North Pole. What animals do you think he would find there?
