Dear Parents and Carers

We would like to welcome you to the start of a new year. The children have already settled in well and are very busy with their daily timetable.

Our Topic

Term 1: Everyday Life

Children will have the opportunity to share things about themselves and learn all about their new friends. We will talk about family, our favourite things and ourselves.

We kindly ask children to bring in photos and drawings of their family to share with the class this term. These can be handed to your child's class teacher.

Maths and English

In maths lessons, children will be learning about number and shape.

In order to support your child, you could talk about and point out numbers to recognise in everyday life. For example, prices in the supermarket, your house number and numbers on road signs.

In English, we will be learning how to hold our pencil correctly and begin to write our name and other letters.

In order to support your child, you could encourage writing and drawing at home. For example, writing shopping lists, writing their name, drawing and labelling a picture. Please encourage your child to hold their pencil at the bottom using their two fingers and thumb.



Encourage your child to read at home and ask them questions about what they are reading at every opportunity.

Phonics

Phonics is how we teach the children to read and spell words. We will learn new sounds each week. You will receive flashcards and a worksheet for children to practise writing and recognising the letter. Please look at these alongside your child's reading book at home. Later this term there will be a Phonics Information Workshop for parents. More information will follow shortly.

PE

Chicks and Eaglets have PE lessons on a Wednesday morning, and Owlets have PE lessons on a Friday morning. Please ensure that your child has the appropriate PE kit. For outdoor games, the children need plain black/navy tracksuit bottoms, a plain white t-shirt, a plain sweatshirt and trainers. For indoor PE, the children need plain black/navy shorts and a plain white t-shirt.

Every item needs to be clearly labelled and in a bag that will remain in school every day. Kits will be taken home to be washed at the end of each term. No items should be taken home during the term.

Your child may bring a water bottle to school. Please ensure the bottle is clearly named and only contains water.

As we like to get outdoors a lot, please ensure your child has a pair of wellies and a waterproof coat in school at all times.

You may wish to have a change of clothes in school also as we sometimes like to get messy! Please ensure **EVERYTHING** is clearly labelled with your child's name.

And all her five little ducks came back!


